# Interesting Cases by General/Oral Surgery Department

# 1. Ovarian Cyst

A 55-year-old female was complaining of pain in R lower abdomen with swelling in the area. Patient was investigated and was found to be having R ovarian tumor. She was admitted and surgery done and 10 cm tumor from ovary was removed. After a comfortable and uneventful stay in the hospital, she is now comfortable recovering at her home.

#### 2. Gall Blader Stone

A 30-year-old female reported with history of abdominal pain lasting for one week. Her investigations showed stones in gall bladder. She was operated and her gall bladder was removed which had around 40 stones.

The patient was discharged from hospital after one week and now she is living a healthy and comfortable life.

#### 3. Multiple Keratocyst

An interesting case of multiple keratocyst in the mandible was treated in the deptt. of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery under L.A.

A 28-year-old female reported with pain in mandible. On radiological examination, she was found to have multiple keratocyst.

After removal of the lesions, marsuplization was done. The healing was uneventful.

# **Community Health Services**



For any rural health delivery system to function efficiently, the Department of Community Medicine encency, and Dentistry needs to play a privotal role. Community Medicine and Dentistry of our college has a prefect blend of medical and dental team. The PCD department aims to spread awareness and educate about oral and dental health and help the general public to understand and diagnose their

ailments and treat them.

Department of Community Health of our institute has been routinely organizing community camps in coordination with our medical team in the neighboring villages within the radius of 35 km. of

our college, to cater to primary health care needs of nural and sub-urban people. It also works in collaboration with other govt, and non-government organizations in providing health care services by sending our dental and medical teams.

In last six months, 36 camps in different villages have been organized till date and a huge number of patients (medical and dental) were examined (about more than 5000.) Major camps were held in

These community camps provide free dental and medical check up and emergency treatment to the general public. Another important aspect of such community camps includes educating and creating greater awareness amongst the villagers about their dental and medical health. #### **School Health Programme**

Our PCD department in coordination with other dental departments also runs various school-health programmes. Dental health care needs of school

children are fulfilled through such programmes. The college has taken the responsibility of the oral health of children well as the staff as members of the schools. In last six months, camps were conducted in the following Schools :

Mata Saraswati Public School Badsa, Govt High School Musedpur, Govt School Dhanwapur, Tagore Niketan School Dhankot, Saini Public School Farukh Nagar, Basant Public School Sondhi, Basant Valley Public School Garhihasru, Tagore Niketan School Badsa, Govt School Garhi Hasru, I.P.S School Ravi Nagar Gurgaon. A total of 920 children were examined.

The special emphasis was on use of magnets for holding these prosthesis.
