MCI Permits SGT University to Run MD Programmes from 2014-15 Session

Consequent upon the assessment of the infrastructural facilities in terms of teaching and non-teaching staff, buildings, equipment and hospital, the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India, on the recommendation of the Medical Council of India, has granted permission to the SGT University vide letter No. U12012/255/ 2014-ME(P-11) dated 6" May 2014 to start Doctor of Medicine programmes in seven disciplines, namely, Anatomy, Physiology, Biochemistry, Pathology, Community Medicine, Microbiology and Forensic Science w.e.f the academic session 2014-15. Having achieved heights in Dental education-both BD5 and MDS- and completed first four years of MBBS successfully, the permission for starting M.D. courses is another milestone in the short history of SGT University.

This plant has the electricity generation capacity of 105 MW. The students visited the barrage area where they experienced the practical demonstration of the operation of gates for controlling the flow of water. This provided the students a first hand experience of harvesting electric power from naturally flowing water, which is completely pollution free. Students also visited the power houses where they were shown the working of turbines and alternator systems. The visit was highly informative as it provided the students the exposure of power generation in a real life situation of the high capacity hydraulic power station.

Accepting the felicitation offered to him, Justice Nariman addressed the students and teachers and counseled them to follow highest ethical standards in life to achieve success. Shri, Ram Bahadur Rai, Chancellor of the University expressed his confidence that Mr. Justice Nariman will uphold the Constitution in letter and spirit and interpret it in the way the framers of the constitution had envisioned.

In his welcome address, Prof. S. Shanthakumar, Dean of the Faculty of Law, gave an account of Justice Nariman's achievements as a legal luminary, including his appointment as Judge of the highest Court of the land directly from Bar, his appointment as Senior Counsel by the Supreme Court at the young age of 37, practice in Supreme Court for over 30 years, Member of Bar Council of India, service to the Govt. of India
