Consequent upon the assessment of the infrastructural facilities in terms of teaching and non-teaching staff, buildings, equipment and hospital, the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India, on the recommendation of the Medical Council of India, has granted permission to the SGT University to start Doctor of Medicine programmes in seven disciplines — Anatomy, Physiology, Biochemistry, Pathology, Community Medicine, Microbiology and Forensic Medicine— w.e.f the 2014-15 session and in Pharmacology from 2015-16 session. Having completed first four years of MBBS successfully, the permission for starting M.D. courses is a milestone in the short history of the University.
