## **Courses run by Dashmesh Educational Charitable Trust**

The Dashmesh Educational Charitable Trust developed the required infrastructure at Budhera, Gurgaon and received permission from the concerned departments and authorities to commence the following medical courses:

### **(1) Bachelor of Dental Surgery (BDS)**

The BDS course has been recognized w.e.f. 25.10.2006 by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India which has been published in Part II Section 3 of sub section (II) of the Gazette of India vide notification dated the 17th July, 2007.

### **(2) Master of Dental Surgery (MDS)**

Govt. of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare granted permission vide letter F.No. V.12017/20/2007-DE dated the 19th May, 2008 for starting of MDS course with intake of 18 seats in seven specialities from the academic session 2008-09.

### **(3) Bachelor of Physiotherapy (BPT)**

M.D. University, Rohtak gave provisional affiliation to Dashmesh College of Physiotherapy for starting BPT course with an intake of 60 seats from the session 2008-09 vide letter no. CB-VI/Dashmesh-Phy.08/12876 dated 24.07.2008.

### **(4) Dental Mechanics Course (DMC)**

The Dental Council of India accorded permission to start Dental Mechanics Course vide letter no. DE-6(66)-2008/A4734 dated the 16th September, 2008 with intake of 15 seats from the session 2008-09.



The Dashmesh Educational Charitable Trust was established on the 20th April, 1999, with the avowed objective of spreading the message of Sri Guru Gobind Singh, 'that the highest service is provided by the spread of learning'.

For the advancement of its objective the Trust has established educational and social institutions without any profit motive for alleviation of human sufferings and specially undertakes programmes and activities for social and economic development in the rural areas.

SGT Dental College has started three Dental-cum-Medical Peripheral Centres at Rajindra Park (Gurgaon), Farukhnagar and The Blind Relief Association of India (New Delhi). The centre in the premises of The Blind Relief Association will meet the requirements of the visually challenged students as promised earlier by the Trust and is an extension of charitable services of the Trust to provide dental care to this group with special needs under the guidance of the President, Dental Council of India.

As a welfare activity, fun games were organized for the staff and their families. A conference of village representatives was arranged for direct interaction with them which provided first hand information regarding medical needs of the villagers. This participatory approach (Bhagidari) also instill in the villagers confidence in the hospitals, doctors and other supporting staff.

Some changes have taken place in the faculties alongwith the Principal who bring new ideas and knowledge enriching the existing faculty members and would be dental doctors studying in the college.

For the academic and professional growth, faculties and the MDS students are encouraged to participate in CDE programs, conferences, lectures, symposia, etc. organized in the college and by other Institutions. Academic affiliation between SGT Dental College and the University of Detroit Mercy, Michigan, USA is continuing and a symposium was organized on 22<sup>nd</sup> March, 2009 in which senior faculty from School of Dentistry, University of Detroit Mercy, Michigan, U.S.A. and Centre for Dental Education and Research, AIIMS, New Delhi addressed the delegates from other dental colleges.

The students and faculty members of the colleges are sensitive and alive to the problems faced by the country. They took out a Peace March in Gurgaon city in honour of the police officers and civilians who recently became victims of the terrorists' attack in Mumbai to show their concern and sympathy with the affected families.

The society in general and the neighbouring rural folk in particular have high expectations from our colleges and hospitals and the Trust is making all out sincere efforts to come up to their expectations by catering to their health requirements with dedication.

### At Centre for Dental Education and Research, AIIMS





## Department of Conservative Dentistry & Endodontics


A 21 year old male patient visited the department with pain on percussion and sinus in relation to 35. Radiographic examination showed open apex and periapical radiolucency in relation to 35 extending along the mesial root surface. The case was challenging due to the presence of neuro-vascular bundle in relation to 35. Surgery was performed by Dr. Suman Yadav, HOD with the assistance of other faculty members under local anaesthesia by raising the flap and carefully protecting the neurovascular bundle. The lesion was corrected and the tooth was obturated with gutta percha and retrograde filling was done with amalgam.

**A case report on 'Corrective Prosthodontics' of the department of Prosthodontics as reported by Dr. Harish Yadav, Professor and HOD.**

A 35 year old female patient visited the department with a missing tooth number 16 and complaint of difficulty in chewing food. It was diagnosed that the maxillary right second molar

and premolar were totally buccally placed with no occlusal contact between the maxillary and mandibular right molars. In order to prosthetically rehabilitate the occlusion both aesthetically and functionally. The mandibular first molar and maxillary second premolar were treated endodontically.

As part of the programme, students of the Institute performed beautiful dances and one act plays with the theme of Holi associated with Lord Krishna.






**रोशनी देवी - सरपंच - अलम्दीन,

मैं काफी समय से सामाजिक काम में लगा हूँ। अपने गाँव में अनेकों संस्थानों के साथ मिलकर स्वास्थ्य कैम्प, जनचेतना कैम्प आदि कार्य किये हैं। किन्तु बुढ़ेडा अस्पताल द्वारा आयोजित स्वास्थ्य कैम्प में लोगों का ताँता लग जाता है, मुफ्त बस सेवा होने के कारण लोगों को 35 कि०मी० दूरी पर स्थित अस्पताल तक पहुँचना आसान हो जाता है। बहादुरगढ़ हमारे यहाँ से थोड़ी ही दूरी पर है, तथा सुविधायें भी हैं लेकिन पता नहीं अस्पताल वालों ने क्या जादू कर रखा है कि लोगों की जुबान पर सिर्फ चन्दू बुढ़ेडा अस्पताल ही आता है। हम भी चाहते हैं कि जन सेवा में जुटी यह संस्था प्रगति करे एवं हमसे मेरे से जो हो सकेगा मैं भी अपना योगदान देता रहूँगा।
