Less than 10% did not agree. It was discussed that the faculty continues to teach curriculum which takes care of professional requirement

3	The practical's/lab experiments enhanced understanding of concepts of theory	54% rated practical teaching excellent and 30% rated. Students understand that practical's enhances skill and understanding of the subject. It was discussed that the faculty continues to take same efforts in teaching
