Vice-Chancellor's Report By Dr. Sham Lal Singla



On behalf of the SGT University I feel privileged to welcome the Chief Guest, the Chancellor, the Guest of Honour, distinguished Guests, graduates and all other present in this august gathering on this auspicious occasion of 4th Convocation of the university.

It is indeed a matter of immense pleasure for all of us to have the noble presence of the guest of the day. Sir I am confident that your words of wisdom and blessing would be a source of inspiration for the recipients of degrees.

The seeds of this university were sown by the Dashmesh Educational Charitable Trust with the establishment of Dental College in 2002 and consequently setting up of Medical, Physiotherapy and Nursing Colleges. It was 24th day of Jan, 2013 when the status of these institutions was raised to "SGT University" by the Haryana Act No. 8 of 2013 and it widened the horizon of branches of Knowledge. Starting with five faculties in 2013, now the university has grown to have 17 faculties. It is offering more than 100 courses in various professional and humanities disciplines.

Sir, an experienced and competent team of faculty is the backbone of any University. And, hence, the focus of the university is to recruit trained and motivated teachers. Apart from active participation and organizing seminars, conferences, CMEs, CDE programmes, the faculty published 320 research papers in International journals and 678 research papers in National journals. Further, to strengthen and enhance the capabilities and skills of the teachers, Faculty Development Programmes are conducted by eminent personalities from the academics and corporate sector regularly.

After visualizing the essentiality, during the current academic session the university has started Faculty of Agricultural Sciences, Faculty of Education and Faculty of Fashion & Design offering B.Sc. (Hons) Agriculture, B.Ed. and Bachelor of Design courses respectively.

In the next academic session the university has planned to focus on strengthening of the existing programmes, research and innovative activities, by organizing more seminars, conferences, workshops and collaboration with reputed universities and research institutes. The MCI has already accorded approval for increase intake of MBBS seats from 100-150 w.e.f. academic session 2017-18. The university is also in the process of submission of the proposal to the MCI for starting PG programmes in clinical subjects. Undergraduate progammes in Naturopathy yogic Sciences, Forensic Sciences, Social Sciences and Humanities have been planned from the next session. The university has already entered into partnerships and signed MOUs with various organizations and universities in India and abroad for academic and faculty exchange programmes that include National Law School of India University, Bangalore, Kenyatta University, Kenya, Chartered Institute of Management Account (CIMA) U.K, Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industries (FICCI), National Stock Exchange and SAP University Alliance.

The main focus of the university is to facilitate holistic development of the students through academic inputs, industrial visits, participation in seminars/workshops, expert guest lectures, cultural and sports activities. For student personality development, industry interaction, internship and campus placement support, the university has established Corporate Resource Center having a strong team of corporates.

To promote and monitor the academic excellence, the University has established Internal Quality Assurance Cell. It has taken several initiatives for academic and examination reforms.

Apart from Departmental Libraries, the university maintains an air – conditioned Central Library with 700 students seating capacity. The library is housed with well stocked volumes of book, journals, e-journals, digital facilities, magazines and newspapers which are accessible to the users 24x7.

The University has ample facilities for indoor and outdoor games and cultural activities. Our sports complex has volleyball, basketball, lawn tennis and badminton courts, besides having football ground and gym facilities. Numerous extra-curricular activities like fun games, festival celebrations and cultural programmes are organized by the university students and other prominent folk artists.

The University is committed to its social responsibilities. To fulfill this obligation, we provide state-ofthe-art facilities for health care services in our hospitals at affordable charges. I am proud to share that the dental faculty screened and treated over 15000 patients through 165 free dental care camps. Sir, it is a service which the University is rendering particularly to the lower strata of the society, belonging to 50 nearby villages through free bus service. Besides that, the university has adopted adjoining Budhera village for its overall development under Govt. of India's Swa-Prerit Adarsh Gram Yojana (SPAGY) and through this ambitious project, the University wishes to make Budhera an educated, healthy, socially harmonious and a developed village.

Before leaving the podium, I would like to wish all the degree recipients a successful and prosperous future and hope that they serve the society with dedication. Our Core Strengths are:

- highly qualified, competent and experience-rich faculty, selected with care from all over the country;
- innovative and job-oriented course curricula;
- labs with state-of-the-art equipments & instruments;
- · library with rich collection of information resources in print as well as digital form;
- wi fi connectivity over the entire campus; and
- Centre for Languages and Communication Skills for holistic development of the students.
- The Medical, Dental and Physiotherapy Hospitals receive about 1400 patients in its OPDs daily, provide round-theclock emergency services with life-saving devices, and act as platforms for students to learn, teachers for research and patients for treatment and health care.
- Community welfare is our key policy. Hence, free health care camps are organized in schools, jails, villages and urban localities.
- University has collaborations with national and international institutes for exchange of students.
- Excellent sports infrastructure consisting of playgrounds & courts for football, cricket, volleyball, basketball, badminton, table tennis, gym, etc. provide opportunities to students for their physical development.
- Hostels with accommodation for 1200 residents, separate for boys and girls, have well done-up rooms, WI-FI connectivity, RO (UV), and round-the-clock security.
- Facility for 24x7 water & power supply to classrooms, labs, offices, hostels & residences.
- Teaching and non-teaching staff is provided semi-furnished residential accommodation.
- A fleet of 30 buses and 19 other vehicles is available for safe & reliable commutation of the students and staff, besides providing free Ambulance and bus service to the patients from over 45 villages in the surrounding area.
- Scholarships and fee concession upto 100% is given to meritorious students.
- The University has on-campus beautiful shopping complex having canteen, vegetables shop, laundry, Food Court, Burger Xpress outlet, Chocolate Room outlet, Café Coffee Day, etc.

SGT University has started over 100 courses during short span of 3 years of its existence and Examination Branch has been successful in conducting the examinations and declaring the results well in time. The degrees are provided with multiple security features so that there is no tampering of this important document.

Corporate Resource Centre

This vertical was set up with the aim to groom the students to enable them to be industry-ready by the time they graduate. It has a strong team headed by **Ms. Bhumika Sharma** as Director and other Placement Managers, full-time soft-skill trainers, language teachers and placement coordinators.

Also, the students learnt the water quality parameters so that water can be safe for consumption.

Both the corporate dental clinic chain are well spread across the NCR region and had sent its executives for a campus placement interview for MDS students. Department of Public Health Dentistry has collaboration with governmental health services for providing basic dental services and the faculty dental clinics work as referral center for advanced care. In the past collaborations with Jhajjar, Rewari, Nuh & Tauru in the form of **Private Public Partnership (PPP)** have helped us establish new collaborations with **CMO, Gurugram** for working in the same manner at 4 new locations, namely **Civil Hospital, Sector 10; GH, Hailymandi; Farukh Nagar & Pataudi.** Tie-ups with various NGO's like **DLF-Global Development Foundation** & **Reliance SEZ Foundation** have been made

in order to provide oral health care to various employees and villagers. Our association with **Blind Relief Association, Lodhi Road, New Delhi** has been working since 2009 where we provide oral health care to various visually impaired children and adults too. Also, Oral health care treatment camps at various schools and villages near to the SGT University are organized on regular basis with extended support from SGT Marketing and Publicity Team. An MOU has been executed and implemented with Reliance SEZ for providing oral health care for 20 adopted villages in the Badli area, near Jhajjar.

The department of Public Health Dentistry is regularly conducting outreach activities providing screening and treatment for oral diseases in rural as well as urban areas in and around Gurugram It conducted around **155 camps** during the period of January to December 2016. Around **27000 patients** were screened and treated for their ailments at the camp site. Department of Pedodontics & Preventive Dentistry is running School Dental Health Programmes under which it has covered more than 32 govt. schools in the districts of Jhajjar and Gurgaon, screening over 4000 students in last 5 years.

International Day of Older Persons

Health Day Celebrations

"World Health Day" was celebrated on 7th April 2016. The camp was organised with the main motive to make people aware about the theme of celebrating world health day in 2016 **"Halt the Rise: Beat Diabetes"** – a largely preventable and treatable non-communicable disease most dramatically in developing countries. A short play was prepared as well as health talk was also delivered to create awareness among the community and make them understand the importance of oral health care.

"No Tobacco Day" was celebrated by departments of Public Health Dentistry & Oral Medicine & Radiology. A dental treatment camp was organized in Bhangrola village on 31st May 2016. Around 35-40 patients were screened and 5-6 patients were treated (scaling, extraction etc). A team of 8-10 doctors and two attendants along with dental ambulance reached the camp site. Stains of tobacco and calculus were present in majority of patients followed by periodontal disease and dental caries. Majority of patients were having habit of tobacco smoking, tobacco chewing or both. Patients were made aware regarding harmful effects of tobacco and role of tobacco in causing oral cancer. They were also made aware regarding Nicotine Replacement Therapy (chewing gums, tablets) which helps patient in quitting tobacco.

"International Radiology Day" was observed on 17th November 2016 by the department of Oral Medicine & Radiology in the gracious presence of respected Vice Chancellor Dr Sham Lal Singla.

"**Oral Hygiene Day**" is proudly celebrated as an annual event by the Department of Periodontology on 1st August. The department was host to innumerable patients both adults and children who had walked into the department for a free oral checkup. These patients were given free toothpaste samples after their checkups. The importance of maintaining their oral health was emphasized and they were encouraged to come for regular check-ups. Sound oral health knowledge was inculcated in these children as they will be the future torchbearers of the society. The success of the program was evident by the positive response that was received from all patients.

"Keep India Smiling" campaign was organised on 1st December 2016 by the department of Periodontology in collaboration with **Colgate India Pvt. Ltd.** Both adults and children were educated on various oral hygiene maintenance techniques and were familiarized with the oral hygiene maintenance aids that are commercially available.
