Shri Piyush Vedprakash Goyal was born on June 13 1964, in Mumbai. Shri Piyush Goyal is the Minister of Railways & Coal in the Government of India and an elected Member of Rajya Sabha, from Maharashtra. His father, late Shri Vedprakash Goyal, was Union Minister of Shipping and the National Treasurer of the BJP for over two decades. His mother Chandrakanta Goyal was elected thrice to the Maharashtra Legislative Assembly from Mumbai.

He has had a strong academic record with All-India second rank holder Chartered Accountant and second rank holder in Law from Mumbai University. He has participated in Leadership Programs at Yale University (2011), Oxford University (2012) and Princeton University (2013) and is currently pursuing the three year Owner / President Management (OPM) Program at Harvard Business School.

He is a Commerce graduate from H R College of Commerce and Economics, Mumbai, LL.B. from Government Law college, Mumbai, FCA from Institute of Chartered Accountants of India, New Delhi and schooling from Don Bosco High School, Mumbai.

Earlier, he was the National Treasurer of the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) and headed the BJP's Information Communication Campaign Committee and oversaw the publicity and advertising campaign of the party including the social media outreach for the Indian General Elections 2014.

Shri Piyush Goyal was Minister of State with Independent Charge for Power, Coal, New and Renewable Energy in the Government of India. As a Minister of State with Independent Charge for Power, Coal, New and Renewable Energy, he launched the "Ujwal DISCOM Assurance Yojana (UDAY)" to revive the debt ridden Power DISCOMS of the country in 2015 and has managed to sign MOU's with 27 states.

He was the minister-in-waiting for US President Barack Obama, who visited India on 26 January, 2015. Shri Piyush Goyal, well-known investment banker, has advised top corporate on management strategy and growth, mergers & acquisitions and equity raising. He also served on the board of India's largest commercial banks, the State Bank of India and Bank of Baroda.

He was a member of the Standing Committee on Finance and the Consultative Committee for the Ministry of Defense. Besides that an active member of the Managing Committee of Indian Merchants Chamber.

He is also involved with NGOs in diverse fields such as tribal education and welfare of the physically challenged (Jaipur Foot). He is also involved in the education and welfare of tribes in remote parts of India and also, support several initiatives for the differently abled.

Shri Piyush Goyal, nominated to the Indian Council of World Affairs, headed by the hon'ble Vice President of India.

He had the privilege of being mentored by stalwarts such as Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee, former Prime Minister of India.

He was also nominated by the Government of India to the prestigious Task Force for Interlinking of Rivers in 2002.

After establishment of SGT University in 2013 and with the addition of number of technical courses, this was reestablished as Faculty of Allied Health Sciences. At present seventeen professional courses –Seven PG courses i.e. MSc in Radio Imaging Technology, Nutrition and Dietetics, Medical Lab Technology, Operation Theater Technology, Forensic Science, Environmental science and Master of Optometry, seven UG Courses i.e. BSc in Operation theater technology, Radio imaging Technology, Nutrition and Dietetics, Neuro physiology technology, Medical Laboratory Technology,



Forensic Science, Microbiology and Bachelor of Optometry and three diploma courses in Medical Laboratory Technology, Radio imaging Technology and Operation Theater Technology are offered by this Faculty. In addition, Doctorate programme is also offered in the subject of Nutrition & Dietetics, Environmental Science & Forensic Science. All the courses offered by the Faculty are approved by Govt. of Haryana and UGC. Faculty has highly qualified, experienced and dedicated faculty members to teach and assist the students of various courses. There is immense contribution of medical faculty especially in relation to the medical subjects. The university has in campus 560 bedded hospital where the students are imparted practical/skill based training in the well equipped laboratories. FACULTY OF COMMERCE & MANAGEMENT

Overview

The Faculty of Commerce and Management was established in 2013 with UG programmes (BBA-G, BBA-HA, B.com (Pass), B.com (H) and Integrated BBA and later in 2015, it also started PG programmes including MBA, MBA-HA and M.Com, and doctoral programme leading to Ph.D. degree. In all under graduate and post graduate programmes, the curriculum has fair balance of theory and practice so that the students find it easy to locate the jobs as per their skills and they are able to justify the positions they hold in corporate sector or academic field, as the case may be. With the growing market demand and enrichment of intellectual and physical resources of the faculty, it is decided to start B.A. (Hons)-Economics and MA (Economics) from the session 2018-19. The faculty has at present highly qualified two professors, two associate professors, and 14 Assistant Professors specialising in core areas of teaching commerce and management subjects. More recruitment is going on to take up increasing teaching and research load and further augment teacher-taught ratio. Majority of the teachers have PhD level qualifications and are therefore, engaged in guiding research and undertaking independent research projects.

The Departments of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery, Periodontics and Prosthodontics in association with NOBEL BIOCARE, the Pioneers and Leaders in Implant have launched a Comprehensive Implant Training Program with Hands-on & Clinical Exposure. The Program is the first of its kind designed and focused on multi-modular training incorporating surgical, prosthetic and periodontal components of Contemporary Implantology for beginners. An Industrial-cum-Academic field visit to water treatment plant was organized for the final year BDS students and Post graduate students of Public Health Dentistry Department. The field trip was designed to expose students to water treatment unit operations, use of hydraulic equipment (pumps, flumes, etc) and environment regulations. Also the students learnt the water quality parameters so that the water can be safe for consumption. This is a part of the curriculum of the Department of Public Health Dentistry. This field visit proved to be useful for students as they learnt the insight about water treatment process and drinking water quality.



The Department of oral Surgery organized a Guest lecture on CBCT: Interpretations and evaluation, 20th March 2017 by Dr. Sharad Sahai; Consultant Oral & Maxillofacial Radiologist. Head, DMD Imaging Centre, Gurugram. The aim of the program was to create awareness towards Modern diagnostic techniques in Oral Radio-diagnosis and how to interpret and evaluate CBCT. The Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery organized a Live Surgical Workshop on zygomatic Implants on 9th May 2017. Prosthetic rehabilitation of patients with minimum or no bone to support dental implants is a major challenge for maxillofacial implantologists. A new modality for the treatment of such cases is Zygomatic implants. The use of this modality is not widespread, and the use of 4 Zygomatic Implants for rehabilitating the maxilla is rarer still.

Department of Periodontology and Department of Pedodontics & Preventive dentistry, in collaboration with ISP Study Group Delhi NCR and Coltene organized a workshop on Modern Endodontics with Controlled Memory Files in Pediatric cases and Perio-Endo lesions on 25th May 2017. The Guest Speaker was Dr. Rita Chandki (Key Opinion Leader with Coltene, Whaledent, India). Dr. Chandki presented an informative lecture by discussing the basics of Root Canal Treatment to customizing its protocol with HyFlex EDM and CM systems.

The Department of Oral Medicine & Radiology and Public Health Dentistry together organized a "No-Tobacco week" with the aim of Spreading Awareness about the ill effects of Tobacco and ways to Quit tobacco. Various activities like 'No Tobacco' rally for awareness of residents of village Budhera, Health Talk for non-teaching faculty and patients visiting Faculty of Dental Sciences and A Guest Lecture for the Faculty & Students. People were made aware regarding harmful effects of tobacco and role of tobacco in causing oral cancer. They were also made aware regarding Nicotine Replacement Therapy (chewing gums, tablets) which helps patient in quitting tobacco. The Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery organized a Live Surgical Workshop on Cleft Rhinoplasty on 2nd August, 2017. Congenital Birth defects carry with themselves a stigma in our society so much so that the patient suffers more due the negative psychology prevalent in our society than the disorder itself. Disfigured nose in a cleft patient is one such deformity that has far reaching emotional and psychological consequences. Cleft Rhinoplasty is an elegant procedure that restores the form and function of a normal nose and corrects the deformed nasal profile. Dr. David P. Tauro, a renowned Maxillofacial surgeon of international repute, graced the university in the month of August wherein he addressed the students upon the art of cleft rhinoplasty. A live, interactive surgical session was arranged in which he demonstrated the art and science of cleft rhinoplasty to the students and trainees.

A guest Lecture was organized on Multi design approach to optimize – Implant based rehabilitation on 10th August 2017. Dr. Anand Krishnamurthy from Equinox India Ltd was invites as the Guest Speaker.

A lecture was organized on TiDiE technique on 7th September'2017 by Dr. M.S Muthu from Colgate India.

Department of Prosthodontics organized A CDE & Hands-on workshop on "Prosthetic Challenges in Implant Dentistry" on 11th September 2017. Dr. Tushar Chawla came as the guest speaker. He spoke about the common problems encountered while placing implants and their management. The Lectures were followed by Hands-on Workshop wherein the registered delegates placed implants on dummy models.



Department of Public Health Dentistry organised a guest talk on "Role of Biostatistics & Research Methodology in Health Sciences" in collaboration with Kent State University, Ohio-India Center on behalf of which, Dr. Mark A James, PhD, Professor & Chair, an expert on Biostatistics, Tropical Medicine & Epidemiology visited us on 13th September 2017 to share his views with PhD Scholars, Postgraduates and faculty members of Health Sciences Faculties. The event organised by Dr. Shourya Tandon, Professor, as Organizing Chairman, with his fellow colleagues was attended by on campus post graduate students and faculty members actively.

Department of Oral Pathology organized a Guest lecture on World Tuberculosis day by Dr Bobby Bhalotra Senior Consultant Dept of Chest Medicine Sir Ganga Ram Hospital, New Delhi. The speaker for the day was Dr. Bobby Bhalotra who made everyone aware about the various hidden facts about Tuberculosis. He also stressed upon the preventive measures for this deadly widespread disease.



The Department of Periodontology and Department of Pedodontics & Preventive Dentistry, Faculty of Dental Sciences conducted a "Live Laser Surgery Workshop" on 6th October, 2017. The workshop included a lecture and two live surgeries by Dr. Vidya Dodwad, BDS, MDS, Diploma & Masters in Oral Laser, Vienna Medical University, Austria. The lecture highlighted the use of laser technology in clinical cases of all dental specialties. Live surgeries included depigmentation and frenectomy each were carried out in the Implant OT with live streaming in the TV Studio auditorium. This was followed by an interactive session with by Dr. Vidya Dodwad, BDS, MDS, Diploma & Masters in Oral Laser, Vienna Medical University, Austria.

The department of Prosthodontics organized a guest lecture by Dr. Moez I. Khakiani, Mumbai, Maharashtra on 28th November 2017. Dr. Moez I. Khakiani in his fun filled lecture spoke on the importance of Occlusion in Fixed Prosthodontics. Occlusion is one of the most researched yet the most misunderstood concept in dentistry. He simplified the occlusal concepts for undergraduate students through his interactive session.



The Department of Oral Pathology organized a Guest lecture to celebrate World AIDS Day 2017 to be a part in the global campaign "End Isolation, End stigma, End HIV transmission. We have fought HIV. Now let's end it." The guest speaker was Dr. Susmita Saxena who elaborated about HIV and its oral manifestations and preventive measures to limit the spread of the disease while delivering dental care.

The faculty organized an Anti-Ragging Lecture for all the dental students so as to sensitize them with menace which is a serious cause of concern in higher educational institutes. The guest speaker for the day was Dr. Ashu Kumar Gupta, Dental Council of India Member, Vice Principal & Head, Conservative Dentistry, HP Government Dental College, Shimla, Himachal Pradesh.



Department of Conservative Dentistry and Endodontics had organized a lecture session on "Cention-N: A new alternative to amalgam" on 5th December 2017, followed by live demo and hands-on by Dr. Phillip Schneider from Switzerland, who spoke about the novel filling material- Cention-N, as an alternative to amalgam fillings.

A CDE programme "Clinical Orthodontics-Back to Basics was organized by Department of Orthodontics on 11th December 2017. The guest speaker for the programme was Dr. Gautam Munjal, Diplomate IBO and former Chairman of Indian Board of Orthodontics. He laid emphasis on importance of clinical examination particularly macro and micro esthetics. The speaker explained in detail various malocclusions having average, vertical and horizontal growth patterns through his beautifully treated cases. This learning experience was an eye opener for more than 65 Post graduates who came from all over Delhi-NCR. Thus, the programme not only sowed the seeds of interest in the budding orthodontic post graduates but also encouraged and motivated all academicians and experienced Orthodontists.





Social Welfare

The Department of Public Health Dentistry has collaboration with governmental health services for providing basic dental services and the faculty dental clinics work as referral center for advanced care. In the past collaborations with Jhajjar, Rewari, Nuh & Tauru in the form of Private Public Partnership (PPP) have helped us establish new collaborations with CMO, Gurugram for working in the same manner at 4 new locations, namely Civil Hospital, Sector 10; GH, Hailymandi; Farukh Nagar & Pataudi. Tie-ups with various NGOs like DLF-Global Development Foundation & Reliance SEZ Foundation have been made in order to provide oral health care to various employees and villagers. Our association with Blind Relief Association, Lodhi Road, New Delhi has been working since 2009 where we provide oral health care to various visually impaired children and adults too. Also, Oral health care treatment camps at various schools and villages near to the SGT University are organized on regular basis with extended support from SGT Student Outreach Team and Publicity Team. An MOU has been executed and implemented with Reliance SEZ for providing oral health care for 20 adopted villages in the Badli area, near Jhajjar.

Oral Screening and treatment camps are regularly conducting outreach activities on daily basis, thus providing screening and treatment for oral diseases in rural as well as urban areas in and around Gurugram-NCR. The objective behind such programs is to make the dental care facilities available to the masses & needy people, to whom these services are not available at approachable & affordable standards. The department of Public Health Dentistry has conducted around 78 camps during the period of 15th March 2017 to September 2017. Around 3300 patients were screened and treated for their ailments at the camp site. Also, the patients were reffered to the Faculty of Dental Sciences, SGT University for further advanced care.

An Oral Cancer Awareness Drive was conceived by interdisciplinary collaboration of Department of Oral Pathology & Microbiology and Forensic Odontology and Department of Public Health Dentistry. It Started on 4th Feb and continued till April 2017. On 15th February 2017, Oral Health treatment camp was organized by Department of Public Health Dentistry, SGT University as per Private Public Partnership (PPP) agreement with CMO, Gurugram, at Government Hospital, Hailymandi, where in people were screened for Oral Health ailments and treated accordingly.

Oral Health Education Camp was conducted by SGT University at Sultanpur Village on 21-3-17. Staff from all the faculties participated in the camp. Dr. Sachin from Dept. of Public Health Dentistry taught the villagers about the importance of oral health.



A dental screening cum treatment camp was organized in District Jail, Jhajjar on 21st March 2017. A team of 8-9 doctors and two attendants reached the camp site where around 119 prisoners were screened and around 27 treated. Dental ambulance along with the team was taken to accomplish the treatment procedures. This outreach activity was organized to celebrate World Oral Health Day 2017 with theme "Live Mouth Smart"

A camp was organized on the occasion of World Health Day 2017 by the Department of Public Health Dentistry on 7.4.2017 at Sultanpur, Gurugram. The camp was based on the theme given by World Health Organization on the occasion of World Health Day 2017, i.e. "Depression - Let's Talk". A Health talk on Depression and its effect on oral health was given during the camp to the rural people of that area.

The Department of Pedodontics in collaboration with Public Health Dentistry organised a camp Sheetla Mata Mandir, Gurugram

A Screening-cum-Treatment Camp at Civil Hospital, Sector 10, Gurugramon 18th April 2017. A Camp was organised near the OPD area in Civil Hospital.

The Department of Public Health Dentistry celebrated World Oral Hygiene Day on 1st August 2017 at Village DadriToi, Haryana. An awareness activity was organised nearby a high school within Dadri village comprising of dental team for oral health check-up and treatment of people. Around 158 patients were examined of which 39 were provided dental treatment in the mobile dental van



An oral health awareness and screening activity was organised with the collaboration of NGO Rotary Club Gurugram at MDI (Management Development Institute) Gurugram. Around 50 patients were examined which includes both the students of MDI and workers. Patients who required complex dental treatment were referred to SGT University for further procedures. Along with the Dental Check-up toothpaste and toothbrush were also distributed to the needful patients after check-up.

Department of Public Health Dentistry in association with National Human Care Foundation (NHFC) conducted an Oral Health Awareness Drive on 6th August 217 at DLF Phase IV, Gurugram. The awareness activity was conducted to motivate dental hygiene maintenance and provides basic dental health education to the children living in slums and who do not have access to dental treatment. Around 97 patients were examined.



A new initiative evening meetings were started by SGT University from 3rd June 2017 in near by villages three times a week. The purposes of these meetings were to have interaction with the villagers to understand their needs in relation to their health care with small group discussion. Newer health care initiatives and technologies which have been added to the dental clinics were also introduced at these forums. Any non-compliance in the oral health care of patients were also discussed and redressal of such issues was also taken care by the faculty members of the department

Dental survey for village Budhera under Swa-Prerith Adarsh Gram Yojana was completed in 2016. This door to door survey covering complete family was conducted bi-weekly on Monday and Friday. Now, Polyclinic has been set-up where patients are screened for dental problems and referred to the faculty for dental treatments.

The Department of Prosthodontics in collaboration with Department of Public Health Dentistry organised a camp at Gurukul old age home in Bandhwari Village, Gurugram-Faridabad Road. About 102 patients were screened.



Co-curricular Inclusivity

It was the first time in the history of SGT University that an Inter College Fest was organized. The FDS organized 'SGT Dental Esperanza 2017' on 17th and 18th November, 2017. The mega event saw the participation of around 1100 students from 25 Dental colleges.Students from various esteemed Government and Private Dental Colleges of Delhi, NCR, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Punjab and Himachal Pradesh participated.The program was inaugurated by Honorable Justice Gyan Sudha Misra, Former Supreme Court Judge of India. Justice Misra appreciated the approach of private universities who not only afford so many students, an opportunity to go for professional higher education but also maintain high standards of Academics along with overall personality development of students. The grand Finale of the event was A Live Band 'Awaaz'.



The Faculty of Dental Sciences welcomed its BDS (I Year) Students with a 15 day long Induction program. Taking into consideration that Entering a professional course is a turning point in any student's life, an Induction program was organized in which the university officers along with Senior Faculty members oriented the students towards the Profession, University life and helped them to build a vision about their future. An Orientation Day was organized in which the parents of the students were also invited and were briefed about the faculty, course and university. A Freshers Party 'Exuberance 2017' was hosted by the Senior Students under the guidance of esteemed faculty members of The Department of Prosthodontics. FACULTY OF EDUCATION

Overview

SGT University is constantly working towards its mission of delivering quality Education and preparing potential intellectuals in a number of disciplines. Faculty of Education is another feather in its cap which offers Teacher Education courses. The Master of Education (M.Ed.) Programme is designed to provide opportunities to would be Teacher Educators to extend as well as deepen their knowledge and understanding of Education, specialize in select areas and also develop research competencies leading to specialization in either Elementary Education or Secondary Education. The products of M.Ed. programme can find placements as Teacher Educators in IASEs, DIETs, Directorates of Education, Councils of Secondary/Higher Secondary Education, SCERTs, Colleges of Education and University Education Departments. The Faculty of Education intends to provide opportunities for interactive and participative learning where learners do not remain passive listeners but are groomed as active participants in the teaching learning process through visits, role playing, hands-on experiences, case studies, research projects, discussions on reflective issues, observations and interaction with the community in multiple socio-cultural environments so that the potential of students may not remain inchoate in the absence of meaningful exposure.

Accolades

A "Card Making Competition" was organized in Faculty of Education for the students on 20th January, 2017. Beautiful and creative cards were made by students in the competition using different materials. Students were judged on the basis of their creativity, material used and originality. Industry Connect

The workshop had been specifically designed for B.Ed teacher trainees to orient them to the concept of Performing Arts as A Pedagogy to reform classroom transactional strategies in schools. This workshop aquainted B.Ed teacher trainees with the skill of transacting content through dance and singing to capture the attention of school students in classrooms.

FACULTY OF ENGINEERING & TECHNOLOGY

Overview

Faculty of Engineering and Technology (FET) was established in the year 2015. FET is ranked 4th in India by Times Engineering Survey 2016 conducted by Times of India. FET comprises of four Departments : Civil Engineering (CE), Computer Science Engineering (CSE), Electrical and Communication Engineering (ECE), Mechanical Engineering (ME). FEThas M. Tech programs in CSE, ECE, CE and ME. FET also has a Centre for Languages and Communication to take care of foreign languages for the students. M.Tech students are selected on the basis of merit. FET has indeed a vibrant Ph. D program in all the academic programmes mentioned above.

FET has demonstrated its excellence in research in many areas as a vibrant university atmosphere with the combination of strong academic and research activities. Both complement each other and the students at all levels under the able guidance of the faculty members maintain this brilliant combination and help the Institute to reach the zenith of knowledge and innovation.

FET follows Semester system for evaluating students. FET uses following Teaching Learning methods such as Quiz, Assignments, Case Studies, Roll Play, Model Making, Seminar, Internships, Industrial Visits, Project Based Study, Tutorial, Surprise Test, Soft skills, GDs, Guest Lecture and International Faculty Inputs. The main focus is on Practical Learning usingProject as part of curriculum, Project Labs, Spoken Tutorial Lab, Online Test, Onsite Learning, Participation in Competition, Regular Review of Projects. FET has fully equipped E-classrooms, Intranet with Faculty PPT subjects, Online Expert Lecture (Spoken Tutorial), E-Journals with easy access and On-line discussion forum (with Google Handouts).

FET has established a unique 'Mentoring System' through which each student is assigned a Faculty Advisor. Faculty Advisors are closely and carefully mentoring the students for achieving excellence in their endeavors. They play an advisory role and guide students to complete their degree program in a smooth and timely manner. They also provide advices and extend extra supports related to thought process, health, ethics & morality, professional needs and corporate life, and for overall development of students throughout his/ her tenure at the University. The faculty has a deep sense of devotion for maximizing the opportunities of development available to students within the campus and beyond. Faculty Advisors are the contact point for parents/ guardians for performance and conduct related issues of their wards. Students are taught Choice Based Credit System syllabus along with assistance for placement, industrial visits/training and latest technology based projects.



Accolades

Students from Computer Science & Engineering : Sonam, Ruhi, Yogita & Manisha under guidance of Dr. Amit Goel and Mrs.Vimmi attended FICE India Intel Higher Education Challenge 2017, Bangalore and were under top 20 contestant group. Project was based on Intel Edison Spark fun Kit and the idea was based on Water Supply Management.

Students from Computer Science & Engineering Srishti Chauhn, Prahat, Pahur Dahra, Disha Grover, under the guidance of Mr. Gaurav (Assistant Professor, CSE) won Chancellor Award in Project Presentation at Synergy 2017 which was held in SGT University, Gurugram.

Students from ECE department under supervision of Faculty members developed new projects in the department. Few of them were E-Rickshaw, DVR and Voice recognition wheel chair.



Faculty Naresh Kumar from Electronics & Communication Engineering department along with students Shailender, Raveen, Gaurav and Sandeep designed "Solar based E-Rickshaw" which aimed to operate by solar energy. The main objective behind the working on this project is to avoid the dependency only on electricity energy. These batteries can be charged by the solar energy. Four Solar photo voltaic panels to generate solar energy, & two Solar charge controller to control the charging & loading current were used. To overcome Voltage sag disturbances, dynamic voltage restorer was developed. The DVR is a power electronic based device that provides controllable voltage source, whose voltage vector (magnitude and angle) adds to the source voltage during sag event, to restore the load voltage to pre-sag conditions. Students developed Arduino based voice recognition wheel chair which can be useful to handicap students. Movement of chair is controlled by voice recognition system embedded in the wheel chair.

Students from CE department under supervision of Faculty members developed new projects in the department. Few of them were Folding Bridge, Seismic Damper and base isolation system. Faculty Anurag and MaliniTewari from Civil Engineering department along with students Mohit, Nitin, Ushender, and Jagveer prepared working modal on Seismic damper and Base isolation system. The main objective behind the working on this project is to aware society about the new technology. Civil Engineering students prepared 7 no. of projects on different ideas as different types of bridge, Green building, IOT Based garbage monitoring, IOT Based air pollution monitoring, Wind energy harvesting.

D-link Academy for Wireless : The D-Link Certified Specialist (DCS) program covers networking theories and configuration lab modules. The purpose of the DCS training is to help participants better understand network standards, protocols, functions, and how to manage network devices. Lab modules cover simple and practical hands-on-scenarios. Lab practice will help to familiarize participants with D-Link products and solutions.

Intel-Intelligent System Lab: SGT University has set up the state of the art INTEL Intelligent Systems Laboratory, in association with INTEL - FICE. INTEL intelligent system laboratory is equipped with Intel Galileo board and the necessary peripherals. This laboratory will train the students on Embedded Systems and Internet of Things (IOT). Students can utilize the facilities in the laboratory for their academic project work and to develop innovative solutions for the real world problems.



Seminar on "Programmable Logic Controller (PLC) & SCADA" was conducted by Department of Electronics & Communication Engineering, Faculty of Engineering on 21st September 2017. Seema Kapoor from Ladder Integrated Automation Training Institute gave a brief introduction on the said topics. 2nd & 3rd and Final Year students participated and had good interaction session with the speaker. "Swachha Pakhwada" - a one week event form 18th September to 24th September was celebrated by the faculty with full zeal and zest. On 20th September 2017, 'Green Campus Event' was organised to raise awareness among the students on emerging environmental issues. Students planted various kinds of saplings under the guidance of Dr. Amit Srivastava, Dean FET. All the respective HOD's and the faculty members also graced the event. Satellite clinics have been established which are visited three times in a week at lqbalpur on Monday, at Kaliawas on Wednesday, at Makrola on Friday by RHTC, Department of Community Medicine. Similar satellite clinics are organized in urban health centre Sector 37D, Gurugram for urban slum and adjoining population.
