Fresh Fruits and Vegetables including root crops are mostly perishable in nature. They begin to deteriorate immediately after its separation from the parent plant and suffer considerable losses during the process of Marketing. These losses may be due to Quality downgrading due to handling: Physiological spoilage (rooting & sprouting), Pathological Spoilage from pest and diseases and Oversupply to markets.

On the Other hand, Value Addition in Horticulture is the process in which a high price is realized for the same volume of a primary product, by means of processing, packing, upgrading the quality or other such methods. For example: Making Jam of Pomegranate and Strawberry.

Agriculture Waste Management by Vermi Compost Batch 2016-20

Vermicomposting technology is known throughout the world, albeit in limited areas. It may be considered a widely spread, though not necessarily popular technology. As a process for handling organic residuals, it represents an alternative approach in waste management, in as much as the material is neither land filled nor burned but is considered a resource that may be recycled. In this sense, vermicomposting is compatible with sound environmental principles that value conservation of resources and sustainable practices. Vermicomposting is akin to composting in that similar feedstock-organic residuals -are used. Both systems utilize microbial activity to break down organic matter in the moist, aerobic environment. Vermicomposting is however faster, produces fewer odors and produces a superior product. In SGT University for reducing the use of synthetic chemicals a unit for vermin compost production is helping to students for enhancing the knowledge of organic culture. Vermicompost (or vermi-compost) is the product of the composting process using various species of worms, usually red wigglers, white worms, and other earthworms, to create a heterogeneous mixture of decomposing vegetable or food waste, bedding materials, and vermicast.
